What is it about?

The focus of this study is to analyze the address forms documented in Sephardic texts of different kind written between the 16th and 17th centuries (i.e. the process of koineization). This investigation makes it possible to check the differences and similarities with the general Spanish system used in the same time and to review the grammaticalization grade of these linguistics forms.

Why is it important?

The study of that period allows completing the historical journey followed by these forms in their evolution, as well as it favors the connection with the data about more recent times in the Judeo-Spanish history.
